- I want to remind pet owners that dogs must be on a leash and under the owner's control at all times. Several parents inquired about school policy regarding dogs and reminded us that some children are not comfortable around animals. I am asking for the cooperation of pet owners. If you must bring your dog to school at arrival and dismissal, please be considerate and stand in an area away from the front doors so that children can exit the building without encountering your pet.

 For you information I have included Montgomery County Code, Chapter Sec. 5-203(a)(7) regarding dogs on public school grounds: An owner must not allow a dog to be on public school grounds on a day when school is in session, or in a public recreation area during an organized activity, unless the dog is controlled by a leash or similar restraining device.
