- Superintendent Jack R. Smith is requesting minor adjustments to the district's current Capital Improvements Program (CIP) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2018, including expenditure shifts for five projects, two new boundary studies, and one site selection study.

  The Recommended FY 2018 Capital Budget and Amendments to the FY 2017–2022 Capital Improvements Program that was submitted to the Board of Education maintains the level of funding for the six years that was approved in the adopted CIP. The County Council's adopted FY 2017 Capital Budget and FY 2017–2022 CIP for MCPS totaled \$1.729 billion. Every two years, the county approves a six-year Capital Improvements Program, which includes school construction and infrastructure projects. In off years, such as FY 2018, only amendments to the adopted CIP are considered. The Board of Education will hold public hearings on November 14.
