• MCPS is now required to make up two snow days. The Maryland State Department of Education has approved a plan for MCPS to hold school on Monday, April 21, 2014 (Easter Monday) and Friday, June 13, 2014, which will now be the last day of school for students. None of the remaining snow days will have to be made up under the state-approved plan.

- Register now for Camp Bells Mill for our students entering Grades 1-5 and Kinder-Camp for students entering Kindergarten. Camp will be held July 7-25, 8:30 am to noon. The cost is \$450 for 15 half-day sessions. There are opportunities for tuition reduction based on income eligibility. Our own great teachers will offer fun activities in science, technology, arts and crafts, and physical education. Math and reading are incorporated in the activities. - Attention kindergarten parents, there is no school for kindergarteners on Thursday and Friday, April 10 and 11. On these two days we will conduct Kindergarten Orientation for next year's enrollees.
- Attention Gr. 2 parents, recently your child brought home a parent input form. We use this form to gather information about students for the upcoming school year, including screening for gifted and talented programming. It's important that we receive your input about your child. If you have not already done so, please return the parent input form as soon as possible to your child's teacher or the assistant principal. Call the office if you need a form.
- *mcpssuper* is a television show hosted by Dr. Starr that provides viewers with an in-depth look at the work of MCPS to engage and educate our students.
