NOMINATION GUIDELINES

- 1. The nomination packet should be a maximum of 9 pages, single-sided, including the coversheet, for Master teachers; five pages for Rising Stars. Fewer pages are ok.
- 2. Nominations must be delivered by 5 pm, Friday, January 9, 2015 by email (PDF preferred) to info@greenblatteducationfund.org or to the Marian Greenblatt Education Fund, 11308 Tara Road, Potomac, MD 20854.
- 3. Do not send videotapes, loose-leaf binders, artwork, or letters of support from current students

JUDGING CRITERIA, SUPPORTING EVIDENCE & LETTERS

Applicants will be judged using the three broad categories below. Supporting evidence, in the form of letters from colleagues and parents to show these three criteria apply to the nominee, will be very helpful.

The criteria are as follows:

Student Focus & Results

- The students demonstrate positive academic results compared to peers and benchmarks.
- The teacher motivates students to excel, with innovative instruction methods.

Commitment to MCPS

• The teacher contributes to the Montgomery County Public School system through sharing teaching practices, displaying leadership outside of their own school, and (for Master teachers) acting as a mentor for young colleagues.

Links to School and Community

• The teacher is active in professional organizations and school activities, as well as the larger community.
