- Parents of students in Gr. 3-8, learn how to prepare your student for PARCC assessments at Understanding PARCC Assessments, a parent information workshop, on Monday, January 26, 7:00-8:30 pm, Seneca Valley HS. In spring 2015, students in Grades 3–8 will take PARCC assessments in English Language Arts (ELA)/Literacy and Mathematics. These assessments will replace the Maryland School Assessments, the current reading and mathematics state assessments. The PARCC tests will assess students' critical-thinking and problem-solving skills, and will provide timely information about whether a student is on track to be college and career ready by the time they graduate from high school. Come and learn strategies to prepare your child for the PARCC assessment. Facilitated by MCPS staff.
