• On Wednesday, October 4, we will participate in the county-wide Walk to School Day. This event is part of Safe Routes to School, a program to create safer walking and biking routes so parents are comfortable allowing their children to walk and bike to school. All students will gather between 9:05 and 9:20 at Cabin John Middle School where their teachers will meet them. Bus riders will be dropped off at Cabin John. If you drive or walk to school, you should drop off your

student in the Cabin John parent drop off lane which is off of Gainsborough Rd. Bar-T and Georgetown Hill students will be escorted to Cabin John to meet us. We will begin our walk to school at 9:25. The entire school will walk that morning. Once we arrive at school, students will go directly to their classrooms to begin the instructional day. We will walk rain or shine, so please have your child dressed for the weather. Parents are invited to walk with us, but it will be necessary for you to park on the street.

- If you are the parent of a second or third grade student, please join us on Wednesday evening. We will be meeting at 7:00 pm in the Media Center. Two topics we will be discussing are the new grading and reporting procedures as well as sharing information on the new MCPS Parent Portal that will soon be operational. Of course we will also respond to questions you may have about the program at Bells Mill. We are looking forward to seeing you on Wednesday evening.
- Our first PTA meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 3 at 7:00 pm in the Media Center.
